

ACT - Registering Online

To register online, you need to create an ACT Web Account,
which you can do on the ACT website:

What you will need:



About 40 Minutes - Information you provide will be visualized on your score report to help you to explore possible careers that align with your stated interests



Desktop or laptop with an internet connection – Mobile/ tablet not recommended



Credit Card or other form of payment



High school course details



Headshot photo - Now or any time before the photo deadline

1. If you have not registered for an ACT test before you will need to create an account.
2. Once you have created an account, you will be able to register for the ACT. During the registration process you will be asked questions about your high school, your high school classes, your background, and your family, and your interests. In addition, you will also be asked for identifying information such as your name, address, phone number, email, and social security number. Upon completing this information, you can proceed to register for the ACT itself.
3. The registration process will ask you to **select your preferred test date, select whether you will take the ACT (No Writing) or the ACT Plus Writing, and will confirm your test cost.**
4. During the registration process, you will also be able to designate colleges/universities which you would like to receive your ACT test scores. You will also have the option to opt out of this section and sending your scores is not required.
5. You will be asked to confirm all the information you have provided and then provide a method of payment (credit cards are the only payment method accepted when registering online).

It is possible that you may receive an email a few weeks before your test date that your testing center has been closed "due to low registration numbers". This is not uncommon for rural areas and ACT will automatically move your testing center to the next available location. Your testing date will remain unchanged in this instance.
